



H1B

(Non-immigrant Temporary Work Visa) AFTER the program & OPT Consult immigration attorney Specialty occupation = bachelor's degree (or higher) in a specific field Duration: generally maximum of 6 years Petition filed by employer & fees range from \$2,500 to \$6,000 – usually paid by employer

The university staff will **NOT** be able to advise you Take advantages of coming up H-1B workshops in Fall, will be announced on GiesGroups

How should I answer this question?

Be honest and transparent!


- Articulate how your education and experience are beneficial to the firm

2020 (Actual) >> 2021 (Projected)





Hiring Trends by Industry & Organization Types



























US Companies International Hiring Plans Trend
